



Murphys Christian Camp is a year-round, 21-acre, not-for-profit retreat center created to

provide a mountain wilderness experience for children and adults from inner cities – a place to meet God in the splendor of His creation, to grow spiritually, to be physically refreshed and challenged, to fellowship with others, and to develop new life commitments. The camp is also available to other groups for conferences, retreats, meetings, and recreational outings.



The Widgren Center Lodge has been rated the finest camp lodging facility in Calaveras County. Comfortable, carpeted rooms include both single and double bunks. This modern, clean, 10-room dormitory includes spacious men's and women's



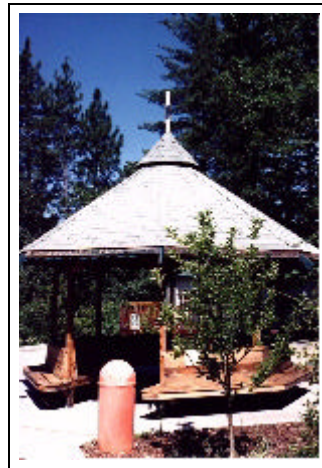
restrooms with ample showers and nicely appointed interiors. The 36-bed Lodge can be divided to accommodate both male and female guests.

The Lodge meeting facility, *The Upper Room*, is spacious and includes audio-visual equipment, comfortable lounge areas, a kitchenette, and separate restroom. Both the Upper Room and sleeping quarters have central heating and cooling.

In addition to the Widgren Center lodge and fully equipped meeting room, the camp includes a homey, "country-kitchen" dining hall with a full service kitchen and picnic deck; a shady gazebo (right); an outdoor basketball court; a sanded volleyball court; an archery range; a playfield with softball diamond; playgrounds; miniature golf course; a park with swings and horseshoe pits; two mountainside camping cabins; an outdoor kitchen and barbecue area; fire circle and outdoor chapel with amphitheater seating; hiking trails and overlook; and even a '49er-era gold mine.

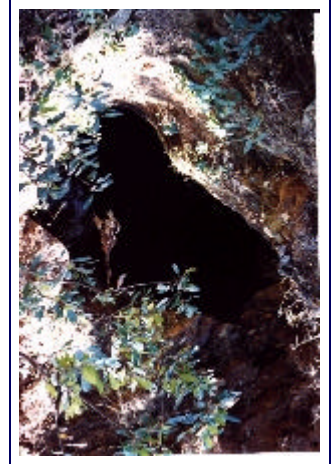


Hayrides are available upon request. We also offer off-site swimming, canoeing, and river rafting.

tucked into Santo Domingo Canyon, located about 2 miles southwest of Murphys. Murphys, a delightful tourist destination with specialty shops, art galleries



and gourmet restaurants, is a gold-mining era town of about 1,800 population in the Sierra Nevada foothills. Known as the "Queen of the Sierras," Murphys was originally called Murphys New Diggin's, after '49ers Dan and John Murphy. The town is located in picturesque, historical Calaveras County. Three nearby underground caverns, several wineries (including the world-class Kautz Ironstone Vineyard), the annual Jumping Frog Jubilee (made famous by Mark Twain), historic Angels Camp, the sprawling New Melones Lake, Calaveras Big Trees State Park (with two groves of giant sequoias), White Pines Lake in nearby Arnold, several top-quality golf courses, and Natural Bridges hiking area are among the many attractions within minutes of the camp in Calaveras County. In addition, Bear Valley Ski Area and Columbia State Historical Park are within easy distance.
